4-20 GARAGE SALES.*

4-20.1 Garage Sale Defined.

Garage sale shall include lawn sale, yard sale, basement sale, or any occasion whereby used items owned by the resident of the premises are offered for sale on the premises. (Ord. No. 97-46)

4-20.3 Fee.

The fee for issuance of a garage sale license shall be ten (\$10.00) dollars. (Ord. No. 97-46 § 3)

The fee for a Neighborhood / Regional garage sale license shall be five (\$5.00) per participant. For a Neighborhood/Regional Garage Sale, the Code Enforcement Officer must be notified thirty (30) days in advance of the sales date.

4-20.4 Regulations.

- a. Any license for a garage sale shall be valid and remain in force for a maximum of three (3) days and shall apply only to the person to whom granted and shall not be transferable.
- b. A license shall be valid for a single premises only. Participants in a block sale, multiple yard sale or group sale must each obtain a license.
- c. Items must be displayed on the licensed premises only.
- d. A garage sale may not be conducted earlier than 8:00 a.m. nor later than 5:00 p.m.
- e. No person shall be issued more than two (2) licenses within twelve (12) months for the purpose of conducting a garage sale.
- f. Any person to whom a license is granted shall be required to exhibit such license in a conspicuous location. (Ord. No. 97-46 § 4)

4-20.5 Revocation of License.

Any license issued under this section shall be deemed null and void at the discretion of the Chief of Police or his authorized representative for any of the following reasons:

1. Creating a nuisance or other public disturbance.
2. Creating a traffic or other safety hazard.
3. Impeding pedestrian traffic.

Display of Garage Sale Signs: Signs shall comply with Section 416 of the Land Development Ordinance of the Township of Neptune.

Section PM-304.19 entitled Graffiti

No person shall place upon or in any manner deface, post hand bills or mark with chalk, ink, paint, or any other substance upon any structure, fence, pole, rock, tree or other object maintaining thereon any words, devices, trademarks, advertisement, graffiti, pictures or notices not required by law to be posted. The person violating this section or the owner of the property, if the violator is unknown shall be responsible to restore the surface defaced to an approved state of repair as may be required by the Code Official.
