- 6. HPC Application# 2012-084 Block 122 Lot 1289 also known as 130 Mt Tabor Way
  Applicant proposed to remove existing siding and restore (if possible) the original siding, replace front steps
  leading to the front porch, replace and install new walkways, install new air condenser unit, install a new fence to
  be located in the rear yard area. Motion to approve the application made by Stephanie Ann Car, seconded by

- 7. HPC Application# 2012-094 Block 6 Lot 466 also known as 9 Ocean Pathway

Applicant proposes to remove the existing fret work from the front and side of the current property as found on or beneath the second floor front gable and side of the property and replicate each piece of fret work, and repair where required existing support columns.
