NEPTUNE TOWNSHIP RENT LEVELING BOARD

Minutes - November 5, 2015

Constance Holmes, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 6:20 pm and requested the Secretary to call the roll. The following members were present: Connie Holmes; James Manning, Jr., Morrel Massicot, and Ruth Johnson. Charles Woolfolk absent;

Mrs. Holmes stated that the notice requirements of R.S. 10:4-18 have been satisfied by the publication of the required advertisement in the Coaster on January 15, 2015 posting the notice on the bulletin board of the Municipal Complex and filing a said notice with the Municipal Clerk.

Mrs. Holmes announced that the Consumer Price Index for September was 261.887, area prices up 0.2 percent over the month and 0.3 percent over the year.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Manning offered a motion, moved and seconded by Mrs. Johnson to approve the minutes of the meeting for July 2, 2015; all were in favor.

Resolution Establishing Date for the 2015 Reorganization Meeting
