DISCUSSIONS:

ZB15/12 (Variances from Conditional Use Standards, Conditional Use Approval, and Minor Site Plan Approval) – New Jersey American Water Company (Jumping Brook Water Treatment Plant) – Block 3001, Lot 12 – 625 Old Corlies Avenue – Applicant is proposing the installation of one (1) back-up emergency power generator system with associated switchgear and other equipment. The proposed back-up, emergency power system is intended to provide emergency standby power for the entire Jumping Brook Water Treatment Facility.

Non-complying conditions discussed:

- 1. Currently a chain-link fence surrounds the property not stockade as currently required.
- 2. Structures are to be located 50 feet from property lines whereas currently 9-9.5 feet exists.
- 3. Design of the building conforms; however, a variance is required for the existing tank which is 52 feet in height.

Jeff Russo, Senior Project Engineer for NJAW – re-evaluated the property after Sandy. This was a critical area and there is concern the current conditions cannot produce potable water necessary to operate.

Matthew Walsh – sworn in – discussed fencing and screening issue.
