**ORDINANCE AMENDING PARKING FINES FOR IMPROPER PARKING
IN THE TOWNSHIP OF NEPTUNE**

WHEREAS, most parking fines provide a current fine of \$31.00 for illegal parking; and,

WHEREAS, it is desirable to amend the Snow Emergency Ordinance 1061; Emergency No Parking Ordinance 1000; Parking Prohibited within designated yellow intersection boxes Ordinance 1038; Parking of Certain Vehicles Prohibited (trailers, oversize vehicles) Ordinance 1264 and Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours (Street Sweeper) Ordinance 1315 and all General Ordinances dealing with fines for illegal parking; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Neptune, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey that the Township Committee hereby amends all General Township Parking Ordinances, including but not limited to Ordinances 1061; 1000; 10-38; 1264 and 1315 so as to provide that all parking fines for illegal parking, pursuant to the aforesaid Ordinances be and is hereby determined to be \$78.00 per violation.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of the aforesaid Ordinances are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistencies.

The amended Ordinances shall become effective immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.
