CLONET/Water Testing

A second testing kit has arrived. Gary is meeting with Gail this Friday, 10/24 and will begin testing Fletcher Lake and assist with Wesley Lake testing. Dr. Brown requested that Gail provide him with contact information of the people who are doing the CLONet testing. Information is available on the Monmouth University website.

Aerators

Dan stated that the aerators will be removed in the next couple of weeks. Dan is going to research whether in the future they may be anchored with a cable, and the cost of an ideal cable.

Geese Management

The geese are not completely gone, but are minimal. The Geese Chaser is a year-round contract. The swan has flown off. Dan stated that a group of swans huddle on Sunset Lake near Catbird.

Bins around Carousel Parking Lot

Open item regarding citizen request for additional garbage and recycling cans in the Carousel Parking Lot. Eileen planned to connect with iStar and Madison Marquette, but she was not present to provide an update.

November Meeting

There is no November Meeting. Next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, December 16th.

New Business

Jim is curious to know when the reconstruction work will begin on the west bridge of Wesley Lake. He would like to communicate this information to Camp Meeting Association. There was no representation from Neptune at the meeting to further discuss.

Jim would like to know where the deed is for the outflow pipe. Eileen directed him to get the deed. He knows the block and lot number. Recorded deeds are housed at the Monmouth County Clerk's Office. Deeds prior to 1970 are not searchable online, but should be available at the Clerk's Office.

Gary motioned to approve \$200 for additional plantings for the Ocean Grove side of the west bridge. Jenn seconded. All approved.

Ed made a motion to adjourn at 7:44pm and Dr. Brown seconded. All approved.
