Governor's Council on Substance Use Disorder (GCSUD) Alliance to Prevent Substance Use Disorder

WHEREAS, the Governor's Council on Substance Use Disorder (GCSUD) established the Municipal Alliances for the Prevention of Substance Use Disorder in 1989 to educate and engage residents, local government and law enforcement officials, schools, nonprofit organizations, the faith community, parents, youth and other allies in efforts to prevent substance use disorder in communities throughout New Jersey.

WHEREAS, The Township Council of the **Township of Neptune**, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey recognizes that substance use disorder is a serious problem in our society amongst persons of all ages; and therefore has an established Municipal Alliance Committee; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Council further recognizes that it is incumbent upon not only public officials but upon the entire community to take action to prevent substance use disorder in our community; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Council has applied for funding to the Governor's Council on Substance Use Disorder through the County of Monmouth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of Neptune, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey hereby recognizes the following:

1. The Township Council does hereby authorize submission of a strategic plan for the Neptune Township Municipal Alliance grant for fiscal year **2027** in the amount of:
