

## TOWNSHIP OF NEPTUNE

### RESOLUTION 26-204

#### AUTHORIZE CO-SPONSORSHIP OF THE ANNUAL JUNETEENTH CELEBRATION AND ASSOCIATED ROAD CLOSURES

**WHEREAS**, the Neptune Black History Committee has requested that the Township of Neptune co-sponsor the Annual Juneteenth Celebration scheduled for June 20, 2026, and;

**WHEREAS**, the event will include activities at Midtown Commons Park, a classic car parade along West Lake Avenue, and a foot parade proceeding toward Springwood Park in Asbury Park, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Neptune Township Police Department, in coordination with the Township Clerk, Business Administrator, and Chief Financial Officer, has reviewed the request and found the proposed activities and temporary road closures to be allowable, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Neptune desires to support this community celebration and authorize the use of municipal resources in connection with the event.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Neptune, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that:

1. The Township of Neptune hereby co-sponsors the Annual Juneteenth Celebration scheduled for June 20, 2026.
2. Permission is hereby granted for the temporary closure of West Lake Avenue between Route 35 and Drummond Avenue on June 20, 2026, during such hours as approved by the Neptune Township Police Department for purposes of the classic car parade and related event activities.
3. The Township of Neptune shall provide the following support services for the event:
  - Use and Access to Midtown Commons Park
  - Use and Access to the Area in Front of the Municipal Building
  - Placement And Removal of Trash and Recycling Receptacles
  - Barricades Necessary for Approved Road Closures
  - Assignment Of Sufficient Police Officers as Determined by the Chief of Police
4. The event organizer shall be responsible for obtaining all necessary licenses, permits, inspections, and approvals required by Federal, State, County, or Local law, including but not limited to Health, Fire, Mercantile, Games of Chance, and Alcoholic Beverage Control approvals, where applicable.
5. The event organizer shall provide a Certificate of Insurance naming the Township of Neptune as an Additional Insured with minimum general liability coverage in an amount acceptable to the Township.
6. Fees associated with Township labor and services in support of the event are hereby waived.
