BOND ORDINANCE 26-33 STATEMENT AND SUMMARY

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Township Committee of the Township of Neptune, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey on September 14, 2026 and the 20 day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such bond ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full bond ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours at the Clerk's office for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF PUBLIC SAFETY EQUIPMENT IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF NEPTUNE, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$500,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$475,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF.

Purpose(s): Acquisition of public safety equipment, including, but not limited to, radios and related equipment for use by the Police Department, Emergency Medical Services and the Office of Emergency Management, including all equipment, accessories, labor, appurtenances and improvements related thereto or necessary therefor and all related costs and expenditures necessary therefor and incidental thereto.

Bonds/Notes Authorized: \$475,000

Grants (if any) Appropriated: N/A

Section 20 Costs: \$20,000

Useful Life: 10 years
