NOTICE OF PENDING BOND ORDINANCE 26-33 AND SUMMARY**

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Township of Neptune, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, on August 10, 2026. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the Township Committee to be held at the Municipal Complex, 25 Neptune Blvd., in the Township on September 14, 2026 at 7 o'clock p.m. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of the full bond ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF PUBLIC SAFETY EQUIPMENT IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF NEPTUNE, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$500,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$475,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF.

Purpose(s): Acquisition of public safety equipment, including, but not limited to, radios and related equipment for use by the Police Department, Emergency Medical Services and the Office of Emergency Management, including all equipment, accessories, labor, appurtenances and improvements related thereto or necessary therefor and all related costs and expenditures necessary therefor and incidental thereto.

Section 20 Costs: \$20,000
Useful Life: 10 years
