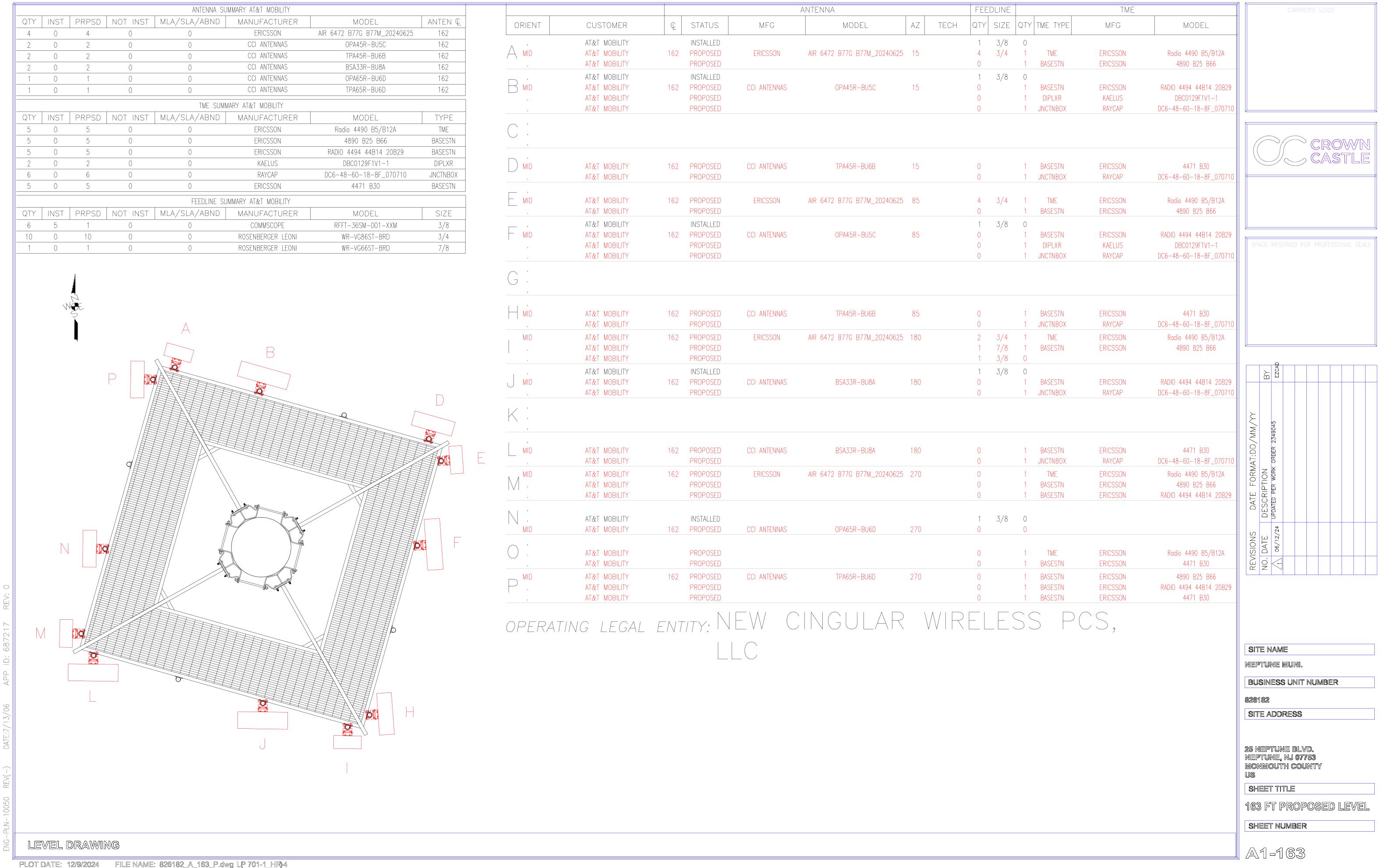

#### BETWEEN:

THE FOOD BANK OF MONMOUTH AND OCEAN COUNTIES INC D/B/A FULFILL, the owner of the property located at Block 2301, Lot 1 on the Tax Map of Neptune Township (hereinafter referred to as the "Owner")

#### AND

THE TOWNSHIP OF NEPTUNE, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, County of Monmouth with offices located at 25 Neptune Blvd., Neptune Township, New Jersey 07753 (hereinafter referred to as the "Township"),

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, THE FOOD BANK OF MONMOUTH AND OCEAN COUNTIES INC D/B/A FULFILL is the owner of the property, with frontages along Wayside Road and New Jersey State Highway Route 66, in Neptune Township, having received Planning Board approval of Preliminary and Final Major Site Plan and Variance and Waiver relief for purposes of demolishing portions of the site and constructing a warehouse, office facility, charging station and drive through, as well as improving existing parking lots and walkway, and replacing exterior lighting; and

WHEREAS, since the aforesaid property of THE FOOD BANK OF MONMOUTH AND OCEAN COUNTIES INC D/B/A FULFILL is privately owned, the Owner must consent and provide a written request and filing the same with the Municipal Clerk any enforcement of Title 39 violations, as authorized by N.J.S.A. 39:5A-1 of the revised Statutes, as well as parking violations of local Ordinances, the same of which must be approved by the governing body by Resolution; and

**WHEREAS,** it would be in the best interest of the Owner and the Township to allow for Title 39 and parking violation enforcement; and

WHEREAS, both parties to this Agreement are desirous of the municipality of Neptune Township enforcing Title 39 laws and parking law violations under local Ordinances on the aforesaid property.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants between the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

#### **SECTION 1 – PURPOSE:**

The Owner hereby has provided a written request pursuant to State Statute to the Municipal Clerk and hereby consents to the Township and the Township's Parking Enforcement Officers, as well as the New Jersey State Police or any applicable agencies to enforce all Title 39 provisions and regulations and all local Ordinances concerning parking and alike Ordinances, including but not limited to, parking, traffic, speeding and other related regulations on the streets and parking areas of property owned by the Owner. The Township Committee by separate Resolution hereby approves said enforcement and this Agreement.

#### **SECTION 2 – TIME OF COMMENCEMENT OF ENFORCEMENT:**

Enforcement shall commence upon execution of this Agreement and approval by the governing body of Neptune Township and completion of all road and parking improvements as evidenced by the Township Committee's release by Resolution of the Owner's Performance Bond and approval, if necessary pursuant to Planning Board Resolution No. 24-12 and the Developer's Agreement between the subject parties of any State, County or Local Agency relevant to the completion of any roadways, driveways or parking areas or other areas used for vehicular traffic within the subject project.

#### **SECTION 3 – LIMITATIONS ON RIGHT:**

The rights to enforce Title 39 regulations and parking Ordinances are complete and irrevocable.

#### **SECTION 4 – SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS:**

This Agreement shall be binding upon all successors and/or assigns in interest of the parties subject to this Agreement; may not be modified, accept by a writing executed by the current Owner of the property and the Township and shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.

#### **SECTION 5 – RECORDATION:**

This irrevocable right shall run with the land and shall be of no force and effect until it is recorded by the Township at the Township's expense. A true copy of the recorded Agreement shall be provided to the Owner upon recordation.
