 - (B) Tree trimming states no earlier than July. Suggest tree trimming be completed between the months of December and February.
 - (C) Annual mulching; will this be done every year or until the homes are sold? Also recommend donut mulching around trees, not volcano style
 - (D) Recommend adding tree guards
- 4. ZB20/05 Daryl Jackson Use Variance, Preliminary and final site plan and final major subdivision Comments: all pertain to page 2 subdivision plan and page 9 landscaping plan
 - (A) Portion of existing wetlands to remain conservation easement; we recommend deed restricted if ownership will be divided among the three single family homes, wetlands not to be disturbed
 - (B) Landscape plans; recommend mulching around trees to be donut style not volcano style
