Focus on planting more trees in the Parks, newly constructed Fletcher Lake walk-way, grass strips. Construction of rain gardens and focus on public awareness of the importance of trees and plants for our environment.
- 4. Ms. Mc Kinley has drafted a rough draft resolution for citizen board members focusing on her concerns of climate change issues, public awareness to plant more trees, focus on electric cars. Neptune can be a model for fighting climate change.
