Following Tech's advice, the Gullwing has been added in a manner that is historically appropriate. Conforming. in style and dimensions.

They proposes all second-floor columns and gable supports will be chamfered. Conforming.

First floor railings to be 30" and second-floor railing to have decorative base panel. Conforming.

Stair newels will sits on the bottom step and will have round newel caps. Conforming.

The front steps will run from the porch to the sidewalk since there is not adequate room for a landing and berm stairs. Conforming.

Lattice will be dimensional and framed in cedar. Conforming.

Existing lighting to remain on the first floor. No new lighting to be added to the second floor. Conforming.

The ridge of the house will be extended forward to accommodate the gullwing roof. While it is unusual to extend a ridgeline, the neighboring house and the remnants of this house suggest it likely came forward in the original design. Conforming.

Proposed gable ornament to have a drop ornament added. Conforming.
