Reference is made to your letter dated November 15, 2023, concerning the above captioned project. The Department has reviewed the information submitted with the Letter of No Interest request. Based on the submitted information, the Department has determined that the proposed **Cannabis Dispensary** will not create a “significant increase in traffic” and a new access permit is **not** required for the proposed development.

Please note that the above conclusions were based upon the information provided and any change to these plans, or the proposed size and type of development may change the conclusions reached by the Department.

Please be advised that **any** physical changes to any of the Route 66 driveway(s) may cause a new permit to be required despite the fact that the proposed “change of use” does not constitute a significant increase in traffic.
