- 1. Call to Order Dawn called the meeting to order at 6:05pm

- 3. Report from Recreation Director—Dawn shared recreation information concerning:
  - Dawn distributed flyers & reviewed summer activities and events, including—Summer Rec is now at 78 participants and running smoothly, save a few behavior issues. Half the camp went to the Asbury spray park today and the other half went charter boat fishing. The July half Recreation / half asset building Alliance Summer Program is now filled at 75 and Art Camp is filled at 12 participants. The Sailing Program, now a 2-week, full-day program is filled with 6 sailors. Other weekly camp registrations for Pony Grooming, Multi-Sports & Squirts Camp, Basketball Camp, Tennis Camp, and Mad Science Camp are still very slow.
  - **Zumba**—new Monday evening class started. Classes thru the summer on Mondays & Tuesdays at 6:15 and Saturdays at 9am. Dawn has been working with BOE on A/C issues.
  - **Move & Improve Neptune** has its site visit set for July 25. Targeting improving community health over the next two years, including: institute tobacco-free policies for outdoor public spaces, increase community / student involvement in the school wellness committee, fresh produce introduction, need more and better marked walking / biking routes.
  - Field Use—successful Soccer Tourney; Rampone Camp—350 girls for week of June 25<sup>th</sup> went well; GoodSports now running 8 weeks of 7 v 7 soccer, flag football. Issue with field hockey not approved in advance, Semi Pro football teams from Asbury using fields, & occasional golfers needing to be reminded that they cannot golf on fields. Dawn attended all.
