- 3. Report from Recreation Director—Dawn shared recreation information concerning:
  - Dawn distributed flyers & reviewed the lineup of summer activities and events, including—a 6-week, full day Summer Rec Camp, Mad Science Camp, Art Camp, Pony Grooming, Sailing, Multi-Sports & Squirts Camp, Basketball Camp, and Tennis Camp. Touch a Truck will be at NMS this year, and the Movies in the Park will be at Midtown Commons Park. The Alliance will also offer its July half Recreation / half asset building program in the evening.
  - **Spring recreation programs** have mostly wrapped up—Volleyball, Line Dancing, Open Gym Basketball, Yoga, BINGO & Family Activity Nights. Zumba will continue thru the summer.
  - The **Move & Improve Neptune** group is meeting regularly, and gathering data on policies and practices. Upcoming deadlines include a draft of the plan by June 15. The two target areas are Schools and the Community at Large. The group has been conducting on-line surveys, in-person interviews, windshield tours, walking tours, and meeting with homeowners groups. The main goals of the group are to increase access to physical activity, increase healthier food options, and increase the number of smoke-free places.
  - Contracts / Field Use Agreements are in the works for LL, Football, and Soccer. We hope to wrap those up in early June.

Neptune is starting a Challenger Cheer Squad for youth with disabilities. There will be a Cheer Clinic and Fish Fry on June 23. May 24 is a fundraiser McMania night at the McDonald's on Rte 33.
